The Lemelson-MIT Student Prize program began in 1995 as an annual \$30,000 prize to an MIT senior or graduate student awarding a total of \$570K to 19 graduates at MIT through 2013. The Student Prize became a national category-based competition in 2014 and the program increased the number of awards to two \$15,000 awards for graduate students and two \$10,000 awards for undergraduate teams in two categories ("Cure it!" and "Use it!"). Two additional categories were added in 2015 for a total of four award categories in 2015 and thereafter. Currently, the Student Prize program awards eight national prizes annually to graduate students and undergraduate teams in four categories. As of 2020, the national competition has awarded \$375K to 25 graduate students and \$190K to 19 undergraduate student teams from universities and colleges across the U.S.
